




On 01/08/2019 Canara Bank (HSR Branch) organised a Drawing Competition. Fifteen budding artists of class VI took part in this competition.



On 31/08/ 2019 as a part of field trip, students of class VIII visited Jawaharlal Nehru Planetarium to see the Science Exhibition.




