ADONA BAA KHO-KHO TOURNAMENT

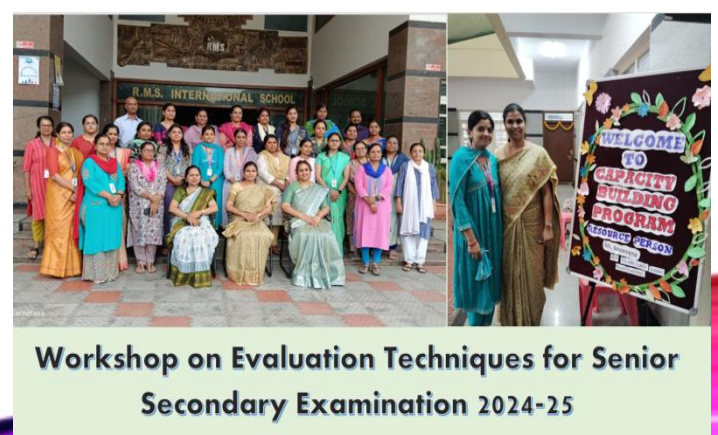
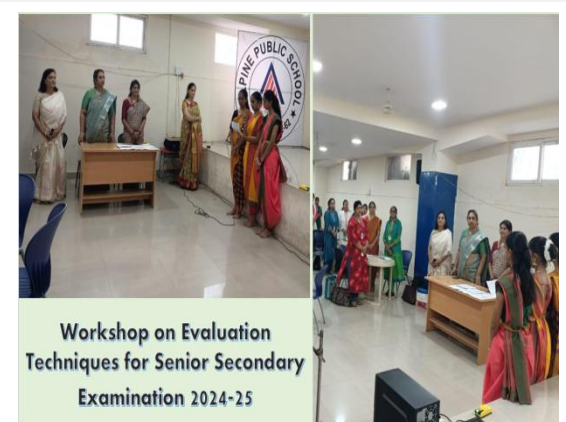
Our school won third prize in the under 16-boys category in Adona Baa Kho-kho tournament organized at Endeavour Academy on 29/8/2024.
