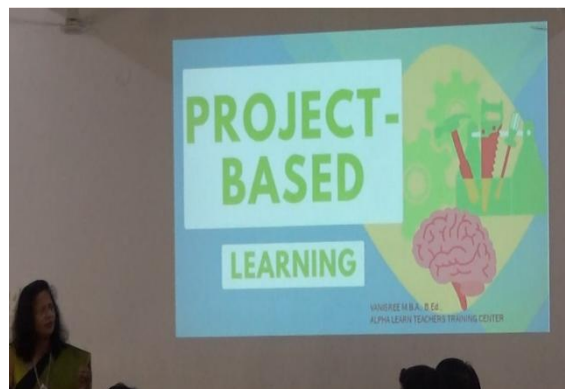
FACULTY TRAINING PROGRAMME

FOUNDERS' DAY

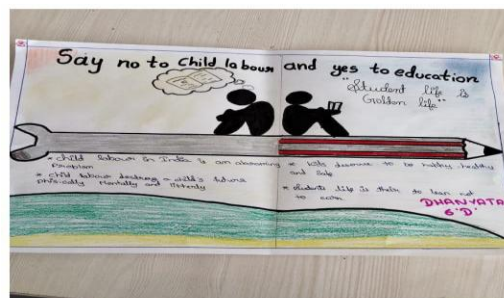

TRAFFIC AWARENESS PROGRAM

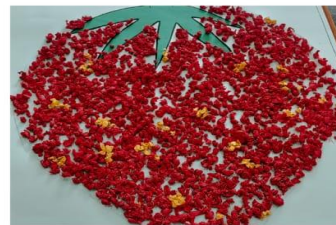
