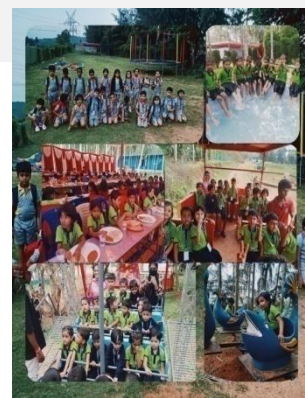


DRAWING COMPETITION BY SCHOOLSINDIA

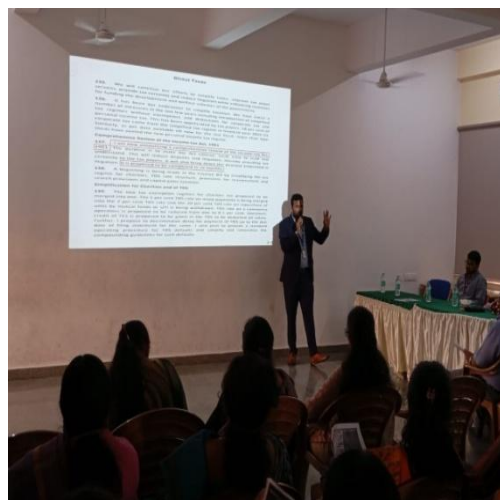
DRAWING COMPETITION

Periodic Test-II was conducted in PPS for all the classes from 25th to 30th November 2024.



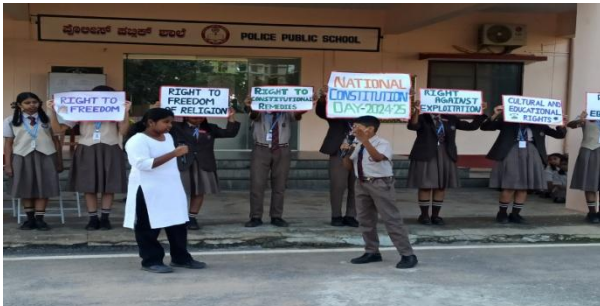
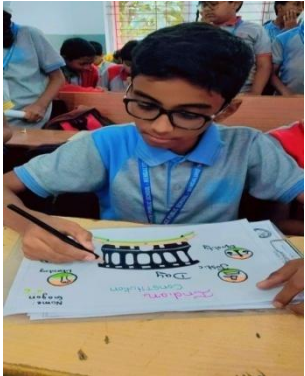
OLYMPIADS
