“Trust the timing in which the things are happening.....”

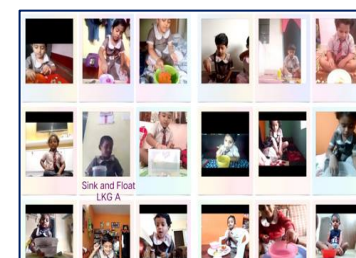
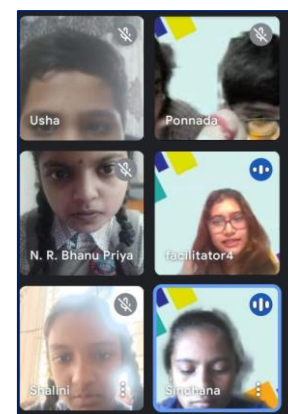
The school was sparkling with varied activities in the month of August. We are glad to share them with you in this third edition of PPS Vibes for the academic year 2021-22.

Assessments are integral for students progress as they add valuable inputs to reflect on the student learning. Online Assessment-1 for classes I to VIII was held from 02/08/2021 to 07/08/2021. Class IX Online Assessment-1 and Class X Online Assessment-3 were held from 10/08/2021 to 14/08/2021.

On 05/08/2021, a staff meeting was organised with Shri. M. V. Ramakrishna Prasad, Commandant 3rd Battalion, KSRP and Founder Secretary, PPS during which he appreciated Class X handling teachers for their dedicated efforts upon school securing 100% result in the Board exams. The teachers were presented with appreciation certificates and mementos. Whether I am willing to change?) test and were also reminded of the fundamental duties and rights, freedom of expression and RTI Act.

To integrate Joyful Learning into classrooms, our teachers had taken care to ensure optimal participation of the students in varied activities through role-play, experiments, music and hands on activities. On 10/08/2021, Kindergarten children were charged with enthusiasm as they worked on creative trains using biscuits, jam, polo, gems and other edible items. On 10/08/2021, the Nursery and KG children engaged in hands on activity to learn the concept of ‘Float and Sink’. Mask making activity was held on 14/08/2021. Nursery, LKG and UKG children made masks of elephant, rabbit and sunflower respectively. We are sure that these fun activities has facilitated deeper, faster and sustainable learning in the young minds.

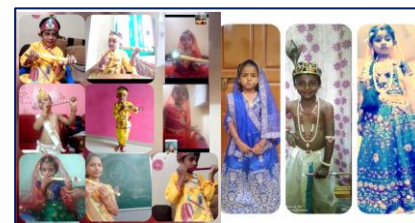
