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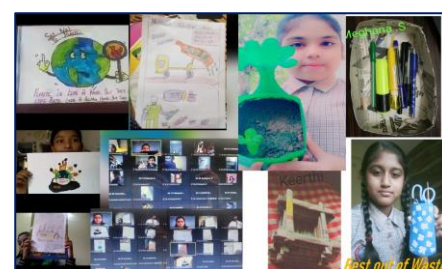
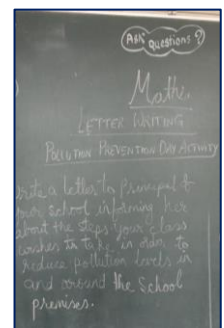
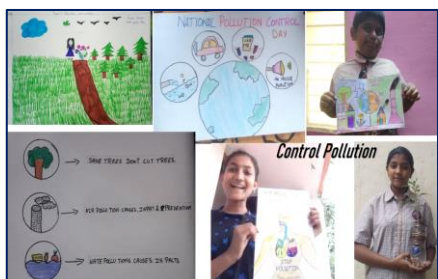
PPS VIBES – DECEMBER 2021

We are proud to share that our school was a **Self Centre** for the Board exam, first time in the history of PPS. 100 of our Class X students took the CBSE Board exams that were conducted with multiple-choice optical mark recognition (MCQ-OMR) question sheets.

On account of **WORLD AIDS DAY** dated 01/12/2021 a skit was conducted by Class IX students to create awareness about prevention of AIDS. Students explained about AIDS, HIV its symptoms, causes, myths about AIDS, prevention and its treatment.

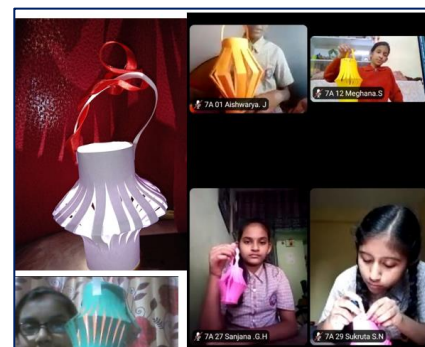

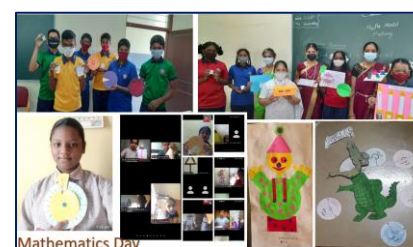

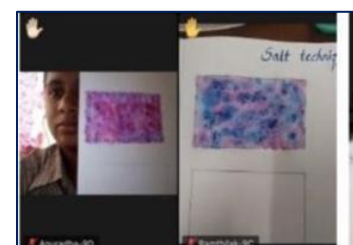


Mathematics Day





Five of our school students have participated in this national level competition held on 24/10/2021, out of which two students - Pavan S. from Class VIII and Haripriya B. V. from Class X got selected for **INSPIRE AWARD SCHEME** (Govt. of India Ministry of Science and Technology, Department of Science and Technology) for the year 2021-22. Haripriya B.V. created a model on Tube well with an additional feature of hydraulic lift to save people and animals who slip into the well accidentally and find it hard to come out of it. Pavan S. created a model on Traffic Divider Lights which will help in avoiding accidents for physically disabled people while crossing the road. The entire models submission was all done under the guidance of Mrs. B. Nanda and the students are working under the supervision of Mrs. Aruna. R, Science teacher. The students have secured prize money of Rs 10,000 each and have brought laurels to the school. Congratulations to our young innovators!
