## **PPS VIBES – DECEMBER 2021**












Welcome to our latest newsletter, the seventh edition of the academic year 2021-22, all of which we hope have helped to keep you updated on latest news of PPS.









## CONNECTING THE DOTS(CTD) IS ORGANISING ART CLASSES
