With the academic year 2021-22 set to wind up, the months of February and March saw a flurry of activities at Police Public School. Read on and be a part of our celebrations....

Classes IX and X had **PRE-BOARD 2 EXAM** from 31/02/2022 to 04/02/2022, followed by PTMs to discuss on progress about the performance of students in these exams.

The CTD team visited the school and held doubt clearance sessions for class IX and X students on 07/02/2022 and 08/02/2022.

Administration of **2ND DOSE OF COVID VACCINATION** was organised by BBMP on 9/02/2022 at the school premises. A total of 141 of our students took the 2nd dose of vaccination.

SIRIGANNADA PRATHIBA PARIKSHA, Kannada competitive exam was held on 10/02/2022 for classes I to IX. 119 students took the exam, and our children came off with 65 first classes and 23 second classes. 5 of our students secured state level ranks and 7 students bagged district level ranks. The winners were awarded with medals and participation certificates.

INTERNATIONAL MOTHER LANGUAGE DAY was celebrated on 21/02/2022 to promote mother languages and create awareness of linguistic and cultural traditions and to inspire solidarity among people of different cultures speaking different languages. Observing the day's significance, teachers conducted activities across classes from Nursery to Class IX wherein the importance of Mathrubhasha was emphasized through discussions, singing songs in regional languages.





Students wrote and spoke simple sentences in their mother tongue and translated the same to other known languages like Telugu, Tamil, Malayalam, Hindi etc. As many as 10 multi lingual languages were discussed through activities.



On 28/02/2022, **NATIONAL SCIENCE DAY** is distinguished to spread a notable message about the importance of Science in daily life. To mark this day, various events to create awareness on the day's significance was held. Class V students spoke on eminent scientists and their contributions. Students of class VI made collages of various equipment in the Science lab. Portrait drawing of famous scientists and their contributions were highlighted by Class VII students.



SPORTS DAY is something that our children have missed out since the pandemic began. This year we managed to conduct various sporting track events -100m, 200m, 400m, 4 X 100m relay across classes VIII to XI on 04/03/2022, 08/03/2022 and 10/03/2022. The various intra class competitions had indeed served as a crucial ground to bring in the sportsmanship in our children.



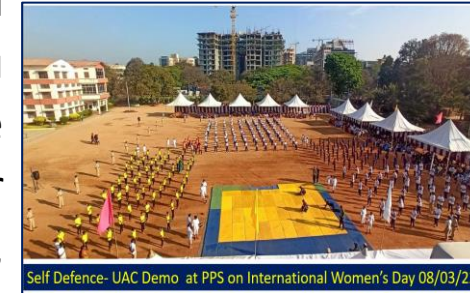
INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY was celebrated at Police Public School on 08/03/2022 with great zeal and fervour. The school was decorated elegantly. It was a very special day for the PPS family as the Chief guest for the occasion was Shri Araga Jnanendra, Honourable Home Minister, Karnataka State. Shri Praveen Sood, IPS,DG & IGP, Karnataka State, Shri Alok Kumar, IPS, ADGP,KSRP and Chairman, PPS, Shri Ravi S, IPS,IGP,KSRP and Secretary ,PPS and all police officers graced the event. The Chairman formally welcomed the Chief Guest and the gathering. The Chief Guest, dignitaries, parents and students witnessed the exemplary display of self-defense techniques by around 300 girl students from Hombegowda High School, Government High School, Austin Town, Government Primary School, Venkatapura, and Police Public School. These girls had undergone rigorous training in Unarmed Combat Programme provided by the police department.

The girls were applauded for their preparedness to combat any dangerous situation they may face at home or at public places. Shri.
