CBSE Results 2025-26 – A Proud Milestone

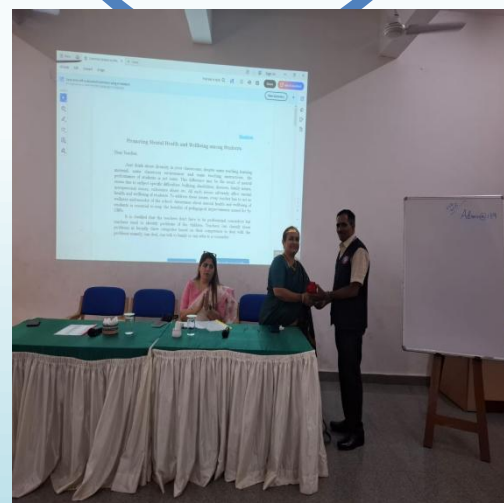

PPS Foundation Day



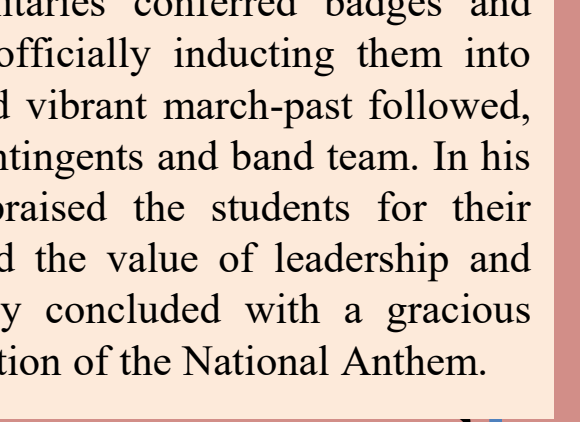
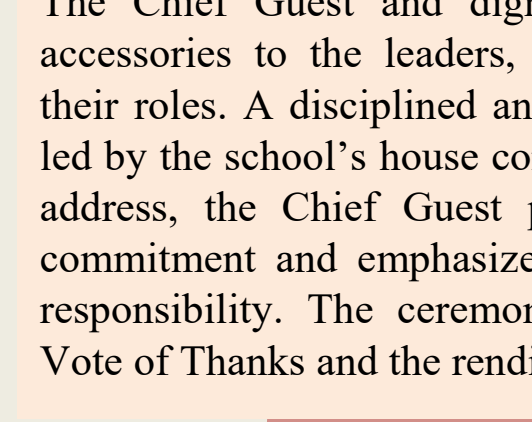
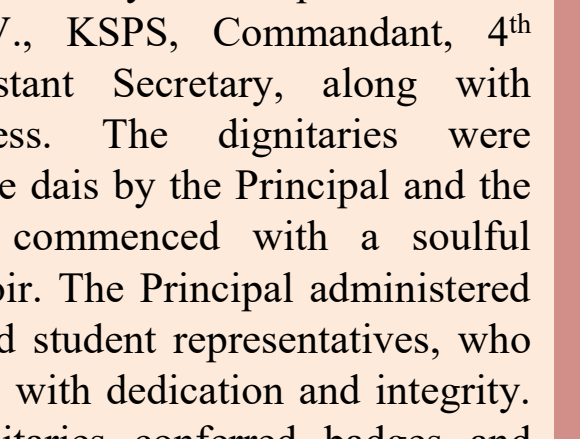
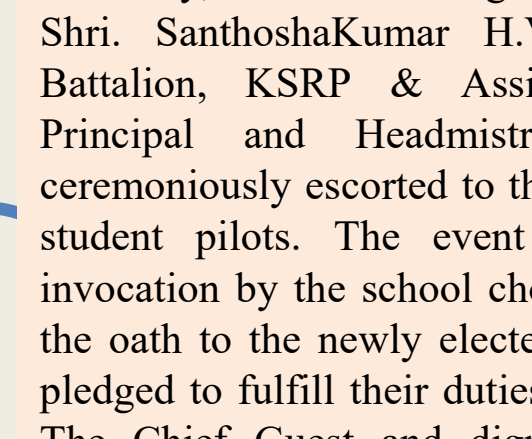
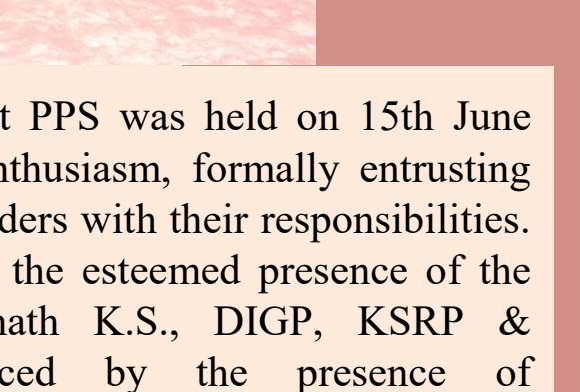
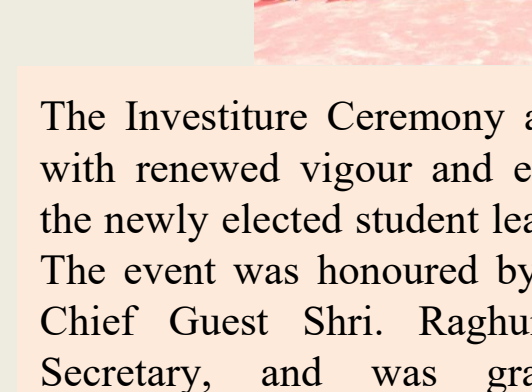
